Travelers to Canada in 2009 Need a Passport

Beginning in June 2009 all travelers to Canada will be required to have a passport to re-enter the U.S. If traveling by automobile there is an alternative to the traditional passport book. A passport card costs only \$45 verses \$100 for the passport book. All you need is a birth certificate and a valid drivers license to apply. Adults who have a valid passport book may apply for the card as a passport renewal and only pay \$20.
