What you don't know about Asian carp poison

As many of you probably already know, in December Officials used Rontenone to kill the Asian carp in Chicago's Sanitary and Shipping Canal in an effort to stop them from reaching Lake Michigan. Many questions have been raised about the poison and I wanted to share some facts I found. The poison is deprived from several plant roots found in Asia and can harm humans if swallowed in high quantities, causing vomiting and death. It generally dissipates in soil/water within 2-3 days. It will also kill other fish.

Did you know

Large soft bodied baits with shad-like tails sometimes get kinked in packaging or in tackle boxes, making them less effective on the retrieve. A quick and inexpensive fix, dip the tail in boiling water two or three times allowing it to sit in the water only briefly each time will remove the kinks.
