The Newest Bass Rage

The shaky head technique is the newest rage among bass fisherman. Shaky head worm fishing targets the predatory impulses of bass, and not the need to feed. The rig is lead-headed jig weighing between 1/16-3/16 ounce, just enough to take it to the bottom, and a oversized wire hook, the worm itself is a floater. The slower the worm moves to the bottom the longer it is in the strike zone, which will bring more fish into the boat. The idea is to keep the jig on the bottom and the worm to wiggle as it floats, keeping the line tight and pluck the line guitar like seems to work best. Watch for the tell tale tick, of the bass inhaling the bait, and set the hook.

Tip: Stick cotton balls soaked in liquid scent in the hollow body of a topwater frog. This will give the frog a powerful odor, causing a scent trail to be left behind in the thick weeds, making it easier for the bass to home in on the lure.

Use Garlic flavored Pam cooking spray on the bellies of your rubber frogs, this helps it skip across the thick weeds and the garlic works to lure those bass to you.
